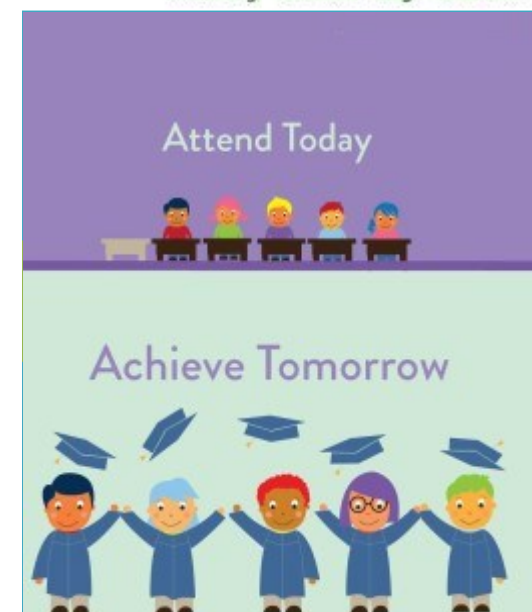

Overexposure to the sun during childhood and adolescence is an important contributing factor to the development of skin cancer later in life.

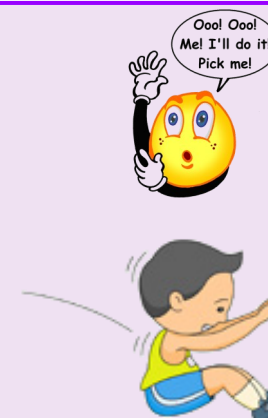
Parents and guests are also encouraged to wear the appropriate hats when participating in and attending outdoor school activities.

If you need to separate different foods, but don't want to individually wrap them, then the liners are quick, and slot into small spaces easily.

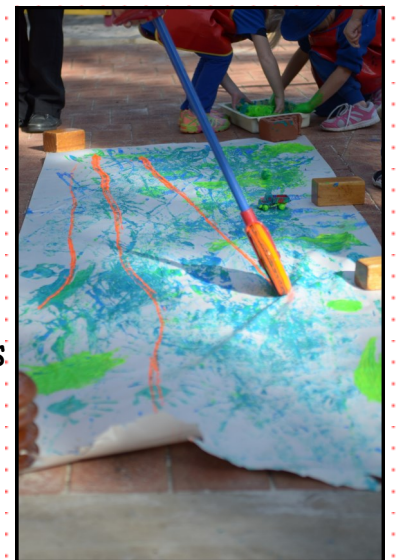


Kindy & Pre Primary Rockin' in their school shoes!
