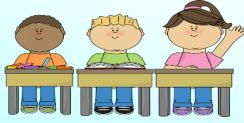

Internet Explorer

1. Open Internet Explorer for the desktop.
2. Tap or click the Tools button, point to Safety, and then tap or click Delete browsing history.
3. Select the Cookies check box, and then tap or click Delete.

Google Chrome

1. In the top-right corner of Chrome, click the Chrome menu > **Settings**.
2. At the bottom of the page, click **Show advanced settings**.
3. In the "Privacy" section, click the **Content settings** button.
4. In the "Cookies" section, choose your preferred setting.

Firefox

1. Go to 'Tools' in the menu bar.
2. Click on 'Options'
3. Click on 'Privacy Tab' Disable the box that says 'Accept Cookies From sites'
