Do you need to let the school know if your child will be away from school? **Yes!**

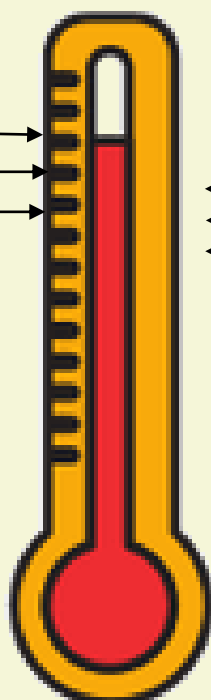
You need to let the teacher/front office or principal know the reason why your child is going to be, or has been, absent from school as soon as possible. Where possible, please discuss any upcoming absences in advance so we can let you know of important learning or activities your child will miss out on. This requires a responsible person, usually a parent, to provide a reason for the absence within three school days. Having information about why your child is missing school helps us plan for their return to school and work out whether we can provide any further help to you.

Our attendance this week is 89.2%. Our attendance goal this year is to better last years attendance rate of 88.9% . We can do it!
