Congratulations to the new office bearers and thank you for funds to purchase new resources for the school.

Swimming lessons were cancelled due to water issues following the excessive rainfall the town had. They may be reoffered in the next couple of weeks. Date for Swimming Carnival will stay at 1st March 2017.

NAPLAN will be online for Yr. 3 and Yr. 5 this year as Pingelly PS is part of a trial school. The writing component will not be online at this time. Information Teacher this year is Ian Steele.

Yr. 3 & 4 commence Japanese this week. Yr. 5 & 6 will not be doing LOTE.

School Development Days will be held Thursday 2nd March and Friday 3rd March. Staff will be participating in professional development in the Literacy learning area.

General Business:

- Leanne to purchase Greg Carter a \$50 Pingelly Hotel gift voucher to say thank you for auditing the P&C books for 2016.
- Uniforms – no need to purchase any uniforms this year. Fully stocked. Centrepay is now used so there are no IOUs available.
- Holly Bassett (ICT Committee & Kindy Teacher) has requested the P&C purchase iPad covers and some outdoor equipment for the Early Childhood Area (see attached letters). The P&C have agreed to cover the cost of both totalling \$1570.59.
- Footy Numbers fundraiser will be organised again this year. Keep it to 2 winners a week and will need to get it organised as soon as possible since AFL season starts soon. Bec Cousins and Leanne Watts will organise.
- Food for swimming carnival – no cold drinks are to be sold, the pool will do these. We will offer a sausage sizzle with a pop top or water for \$5 and will need donations of cakes for morning tea. Will provide coffee and tea for sale. Tara to organise.
- Pingelly Shears is on this Saturday. P&C will offer bacon and egg burgers for breakfast (\$6), sausage sizzle for lunch(\$4), tea, coffee, water(\$3), cool drinks (\$3) and Powerade(\$4). Helpers to be there at 8am, starts at 9am. School will allow P&C to borrow shelter. Tara, Lee, Sheree, Emma, Sarah and Jo will assist.
- There are no lunch orders this year. We have been approached to provide a canteen maybe once a week for the students. People power may be an issue. It was discussed to sell pies, pasties and sausage rolls by order only. We can use the freezer to store frozen food, and are allowed to use the ovens in the Home Ec room to heat pies up. The shire will need to check the ovens prior to use. It was suggested that we deliver to the classes rather than kids coming to pick up their orders. Sheree volunteered to oversee ordering of stock. This will be discussed more at the next P&C meeting. Aim to have it up and running by Term 2, 2017.
- Nature Playground - \$3300 left to spend. It was asked whether to spend the remaining amount on equipment for the playground as the committee have run out of steam. This amount will only purchase a minimal amount so it was decided to continue working on the playground and not use the rest of this money at this point in time.

- Number plates fundraiser – Advertise in the next Pingelly Times entry to see if we receive any more orders before putting the order in. Michelle to add this to the notes in the Pingelly Times.
- Members were asked to think of more fundraising ideas to bring along to next meeting.
