Dear Parents

At Pingelly Primary School we are continuously striving to improve the quality of education that we provide to our students. In doing so, we recognise the need to improve how our communication and interactions with our parents and the community to help increase the support for each child's education.

In order to identify the areas that need to be maintained and the areas that require improvement, we will be seeking feedback from parents and the community via a telephone interview.

To help us gather this information, Pingelly Primary School has appointed an independent company, Creating Communities Australia Pty Ltd, who are very experienced in community engagement and school development. They will conduct an independent telephone survey of our parents and stakeholders. This survey will cover a range of aspects about the school, including how it is perceived and what areas need future attention. Creating Communities will produce an independent report that will include recommended strategies to guide our school's future development.

We greatly value feedback from our parents and community and strongly encourage you to be involved. The parents of each child will be offered an opportunity to take part in the confidential individual phone interview. The interview will take approximately 20-30 minutes with a member of the Creating Communities team and will take place between 19 July and 2 August 2017. Creating Communities will contact you directly to see if you are willing to be involved in an interview.

Please be assured that the feedback you provide will not be attributed to you directly, nor will you be identified in any reporting. There will be no identification of individuals in the reporting.

While we strongly encourage you to be involved, it is of course optional. If you do not wish to be involved, please contact the school on Pingelly.ps@education.wa.edu.au by 17 July, 2017 and your contact details will not be provided to Creating Communities.

If a member of the Creating Communities team contacts you at an inconvenient time for the interview, you can organise an alternative time which suits you better.
