PHONES / SMART WATCHES

Here at Pingelly Primary School, students are banned from using mobile phones from the time they arrive to the conclusion of the school day. Mobile phones and electronic devices, such as iPads and iPods, will be switched off and handed in to the office for safe storage and will be available for collection at the end of the day.

This is in line with the Department's policy that students from Kindergarten to Year 6 are not permitted to have mobile phones in their possession during the school day.

Similarly, we require students to put their smart watches in 'aeroplane mode' so phone calls and messages cannot be sent or received during the school day. Games and photos are not to be accessed during the school day using smart watches.

Teachers will reiterate this message to students. Parents and carers, please ensure that your child(ren) understand that the decision to ban the use of mobile phones in schools is intended to remove the potential learning distraction for students, protect the privacy of staff and students, improve social connections at school and improve the health and wellbeing of students.
